2019 Team Competitions – NLG Area 3 Qualifiers

Please see below a list of team competitions (area qualifiers) which R&DRC are eligible to enter and qualify for the many BRC National Championships which are held throughout the year.

All members are eligible to represent R&DRC at the area qualifiers and this is a good opportunity to compete at a higher level competition. The area qualifiers occur throughout the year and it is important to contact Team Managers at least a month before the qualifier so that team and individual entries can be made. Please see below a few guidelines but see www.rochdalerc.co.uk for a full list of guidelines:-

- Membership fees must be received **SIX WEEKS** before the date of the qualifier.
- Any member wishing to be considered for team selection must please contact the relevant Team Manager.
- **All animals must have a valid up-to-date Vaccination Record and Passport which will be required for inspection at the qualifiers and championships. Please note animals may compete providing they have had the first two primary injections and no injection should be given on any of the 6 days before a competition; e.g. if an animal is vaccinated on a Monday it will not be eligible to compete, or enter the championship stables, until the following Monday.**
- Members are requested to pay for the qualifier entry fees, however, if you are fortunate enough to qualify for the Nationals the club pay for the championship entry fees but members are required to contribute towards the cost of the championship stabling.
- **All qualifying teams will be required to provide a volunteer to steward at the championships or the team will not be entered.**

There is range of classes to suit most abilities at the area qualifiers but please note members must be available to compete at the relevant championships should the club qualify. Even if you are not a member of the qualifying team you may be required as a reserve.

The team competitions are a great way of meeting new friends within our riding club and also team members from the other 23 clubs that are members of the NLG Area 3. Whilst the emphasis is on supporting your team mates and having fun the competitions also create great opportunities for weekends away and the chance to compete at some fantastic venues around the country. No members are turned away from team/individual competitions so if you are interested please contact the relevant Team Managers early.
