At the July Dressage Trophies and Championship Rosettes will be awarded as follows:-

Junior	Highest combined percentage score from any TWO dressage tests (classes 4 to 10)
12 years & under	Highest combined percentage score from any TWO dressage tests (classes 4 to 10)
Senior	Highest combined percentage score from any TWO dressage tests (classes 4 to 10)
Member	Highest placed R&DRC member (as above)
Team	Best THREE percentage scores to count (classes 1 to 10) – Teams of Four
Intro (Trophy Only)	Combination with highest percentage score (classes 1 to 3)

- Teams of four may consist of any combination of junior and senior competitors. One class per team member from classes 1 to 10. Please confirm teams when entering.
- No horse or rider may compete twice in the same team.
- Competitors may enter as many classes as they wish but no combination may appear in more than ONE team.

ROR Challenge Qualifiers – April, May, June, July & August

Notes, guidelines and rules:-

1. All ages at 1st January in the current year.
2. **Intro and Senior Beginners:** Combinations not to have been placed 1st to 6th in an open Dressage class at R&DRC previous to the current season.
3. Combinations are eligible to enter a combination of classes as follows:-
 - ❖ Lead Rein Intro
 - ❖ Junior/Senior Intro and Senior Beginners/Junior Prelim
 - ❖ Senior Beginners and Senior Prelim
 - ❖ Junior/Senior Prelim and Junior/Senior Novice
 - ❖ Junior/Senior Novice and Open Elementary
4. All classes are to be ridden in a British Dressage permitted snaffle bridle with either a drop, flash, crossed or cavesson noseband with the exception of the Elementary which may be ridden in a simple double bridle.
5. Lead rein is to be ridden in a British Dressage permitted snaffle bridle with the lead rein attached to the noseband only. Competitors entering the lead rein class are ineligible to enter classes off the lead and vice versa.
6. All riders must wear protective headwear with the harness correctly adjusted and fastened. Protective headwear constitutes a hat that meets the standards as detailed in the Riding Club Rules.
7. Rosettes to 4th in all classes and points awarded to members. If 8 or more competitors rosettes will be placed to 6th.
8. HC and late entries will be accepted subject to availability. Late entries will incur a £2.00 surcharge per class as detailed below. Closing date is the Tuesday before each competition.
9. Priority will be given to R&DRC members. However, we will endeavour to accommodate all entries received.
10. Competitors and spectators must abide by the Club Rules.
